



ELECTION WORKER POSITIONS

To apply for or inquire about any of the positions below, please complete the Election Worker Application.

- **Election Judge**

A person appointed by the Commissioners Court for an upcoming election. This person oversees the operation of a particular polling place on election day. He/she contacts the polling place and makes arrangements for opening/closing the polling place on election day. Receives and accepts custody of equipment and returns designated items to Central Count the night of the election.

- **Alternate Judge**

A person appointed by the Commissioners Court for an upcoming election. This person is to assist the Election Judge in their duties. If for any reason the Election Judge is unable to perform their duties, it's the responsibility of the Alternate Judge to step in and take over as Elections Judge. The Alternate Judge should be affiliated with a different political party than that of the Election Judge.

- **Clerk**

A clerk is to assist the Judge and Alternate Judge in performing the assigned duties that they are given.

Pay Rate & Schedule

Each person who is willing to work as a Judge, Alternate Judge, Election Clerk or Bilingual Election Clerk must attend a mandatory training class. This is a 3-hour class and is usually held before early voting begins for the election. It is held at the Bowie County Courthouse in New Boston TX. Election day polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. You will need to get to your polling place early enough to set up and stay late enough to take everything down.
