

PRESS RELEASE FROM THE NEW BOSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT

EFFECTIVE JUNE 9, 2022

A VTR-68-A is an inspection conducted by a law enforcement officer to verify the identity of a vehicle for registration purposes. This inspection is often needed to obtain a bonded title, register a homemade trailer, register a motor vehicle that previously has not had a title, or for other reasons.

The New Boston Police Auto Theft Investigators will begin conducting 68-A Inspections for residents of Bowie County and surrounding areas. Investigators will conduct inspections at 108 N. Center and 303 W. Walters Blvd. New Boston, TX, the inspector does not come to your home or business. N.B.P.D. will conduct inspections on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month excluding holidays.

To schedule an appointment, contact the New Boston Police Department (903) 628-3771, complete an inspection request form, and pay a \$40.00 inspection fee. In addition, you will need to arrange to bring your vehicle or trailer to the inspection location. You must show your photo I.D. and the title of the vehicle or trailer to be inspected. In cases of homemade vehicles or trailers that are not titled, you must bring written proof of manufacture, bill of sale, and any other documentation to substantiate its manufacturer or ownership. If your vehicle was a gift or inheritance, please bring related documentation.
